This textbook will be in the classroom. You will have access to the book online from home through powerschool. Directions for how to access the textbook online will be handed out shortly.

They are always announced ahead of time and a study guide is provided for each.

**Quizzes** – Quizzes are given as needed throughout a unit. They will usually be announced, and no study guide will be provided.

Lab Reports - Laboratory work occurs very frequently and may require a formal write up or packet to complete. When absent you have ONE WEEK to make up the lab, otherwise it is a ZERO. You must arrange for the makeup, I will not remind you. Homework and Classwork – Homework is assigned to enhance your learning/understanding of the content covered in class. Therefore, it is assigned on an "as needed" basis. Homework will consist of worksheets problems, reading, or studying. You can expect most unfinished classwork to be assigned as homework.

**Notebooks** – A science notebook cover page or table of contents will be given out at the beginning of each chapter or unit we study. The notebook sheet will be updated daily and will also be posted on my website. Please be sure to keep your notebook up to date and well organized. Notebooks are collected on the same day you take your test.

**Projects** – Projects are assigned throughout each unit. Most will be done in cooperative groups and require everyone to participate equally in the work and presentations required for each.

**Absent from Class Policy:** When you are absent you will have ONE WEEK to make up any test/quiz, otherwise it is a ZERO. If you cut class on the day of a test/quiz or have an unexcused absence, you will receive a **zero** and lose the opportunity to make it up. If you were absent the day before the test, and thus missed the in-class review, you are STILL responsible for taking test that day. It is your responsibility to contact a classmate to get necessary information. It is your responsibility to retrieve your makeup work as soon as you return to school. Check my website and speak to me regarding the work you missed.

**Pass Policy:** If you are late for class without a pass, you will receive a tardy. On your 3<sup>rd</sup> tardy you will be assigned an afterschool detention with me. You MUST have a pass to leave the classroom. If you are late MORE than 10 minutes to class, without a pass, you will receive an absence for the day.

Extra Help: I am available for extra help most days after school, please just make an appointment to stay.

Cell phone and Electronic Devices: They are not permitted in class.

Communicating via text/phone is prohibited and disruptive. Any excessive requests to put phone away will result in a phone call home and other appropriate actions.
